A Letter from *Our* CEO.



By God's grace, 2024 marked a year of multiplication. A year of Jesus working in new cities, with new leaders, in new ways. We witnessed 9 new cities and 3 online communities start. Our community created 28 redemptive tech products that were put into real-world use. And we hosted over 170 events. Well done community. You guys are awesome!

In 2024 alone, FaithTech Australia launched and grew to 4 cities: Adelaide, Brisbane, Melbourne, and Sydney. Thank you Jesus for raising up a community of incredible leaders in Australia.

In January, 2024 that we formally launched our five value statements. What we call our Pillars: it all points back to Jesus, led by the spirit, take a sacrificial posture, people over products, and we don't take ourselves too seriously. These are WHO FaithTech is. It is what drives us. Our DNA. We started asking: how does everything we do as FaithTech be rooted in and come back to these pillars?

The result: a growing clarity on direction and what we say yes and no to. It truly felt like a turning point for us. Again, thank you Jesus!

A few other highlights from 2024 were things like hosting our first-ever FaithTech Asia One Day Digital Summit, hosting our Global Staff retreat in Waterloo & Niagara Falls, and hosting a discovery meetup in London, England. I personally spent April in San Francisco with my family with the opportunity to minister to our community in the region, tech executives, and a few hundred faith-driven leaders. Lastly, a whole bunch of FaithTechers met in Seoul, South Korea for the Lausanne Congress where we helped lead the Digital Discovery Centre and educate the global church on technology.

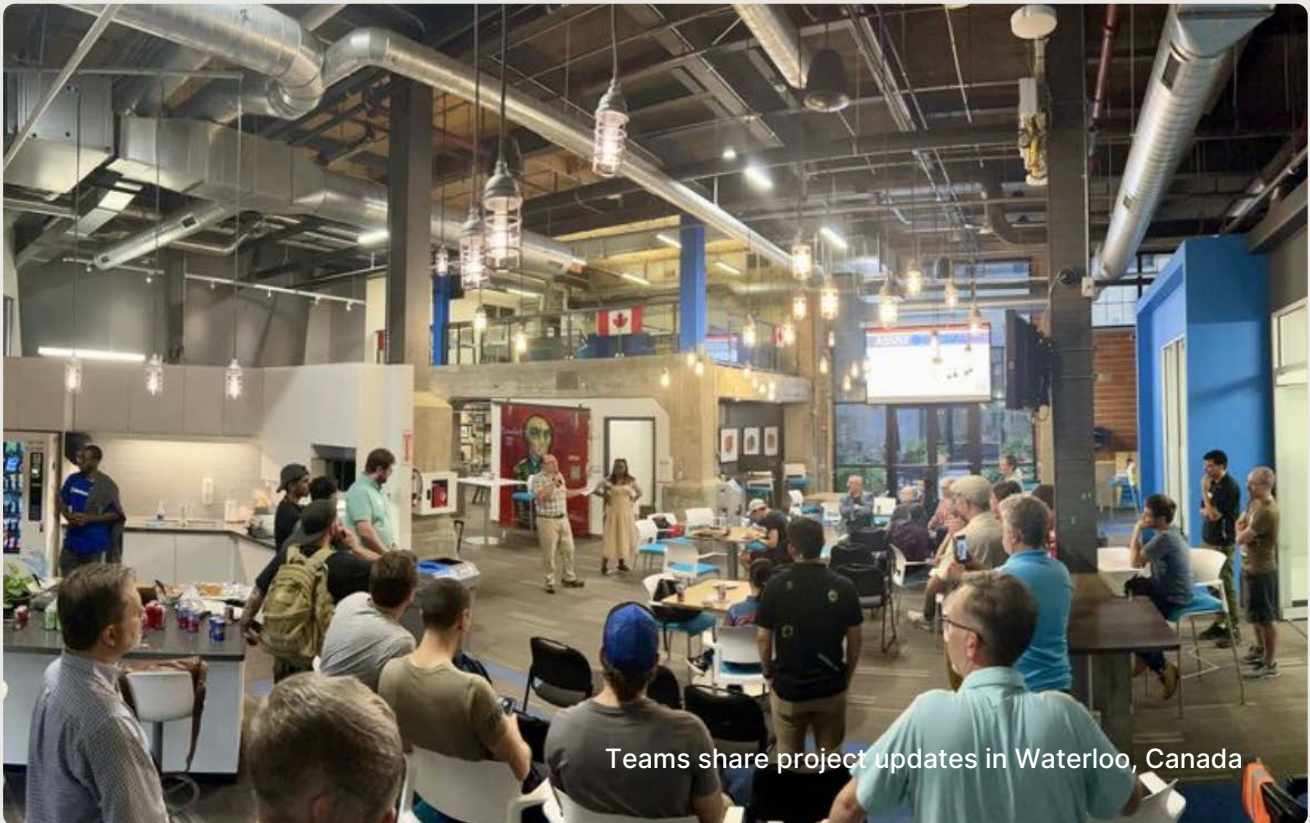
Now, 2024 wasn't all sunshine. We struggled to manage the growth. Our pace of leadership onboarding outpaced our ability to train and coach the way we wanted. We felt as a global staff we were constantly not providing the level of coaching, resourcing, and training our leaders needed. Moreover, we had several unexpected health issues with our team. God taught is tremendously through this and we started making changes that has helped us into 2025.

Yet, coming off our first ever City Leaders Summit in the fall of 2023, our leaders were sent out to find and train other leaders to serve their cities. By God's grace, we saw more people impacted, more events, more products built, and more leaders trained and raised up. We are so thankful to have had our largest year of revenue that helped us achieve all these Jesus-sized outcomes.

At the core of this all, I hope you see, is a community fixated on one thing. Or should I say, one person. Jesus. It all points back to Jesus.

Thank you to everyone who played a role in this wild Jesus-centered movement we call FaithTech.

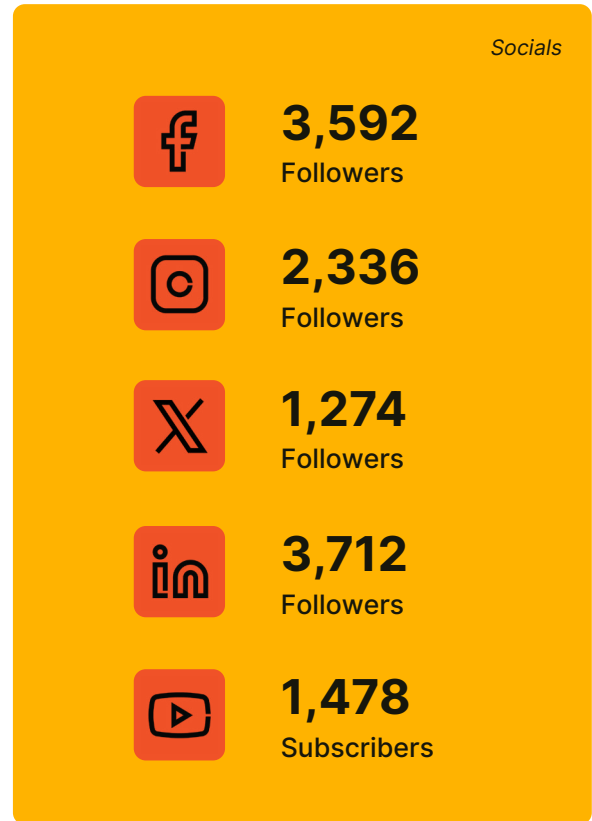
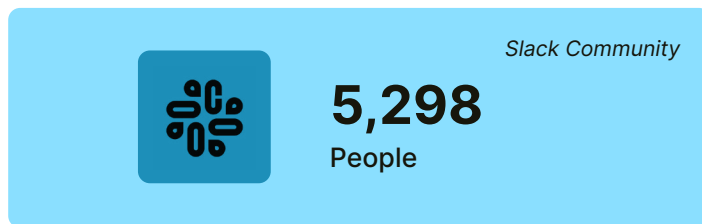
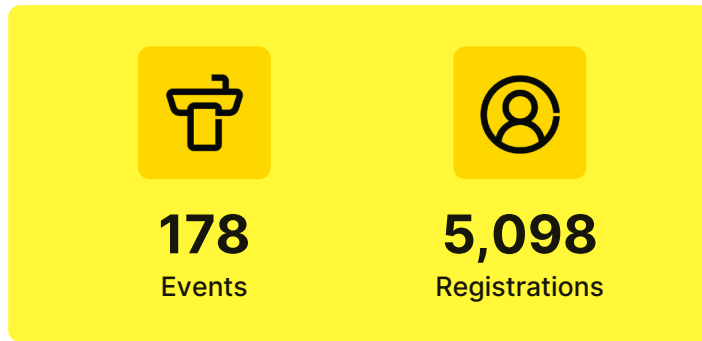

Building a mobile app to extend Banda Health’s impact to frontline clinics in Kenyan slums and villages — currently 104 clinics reaching 550,000 patients per year

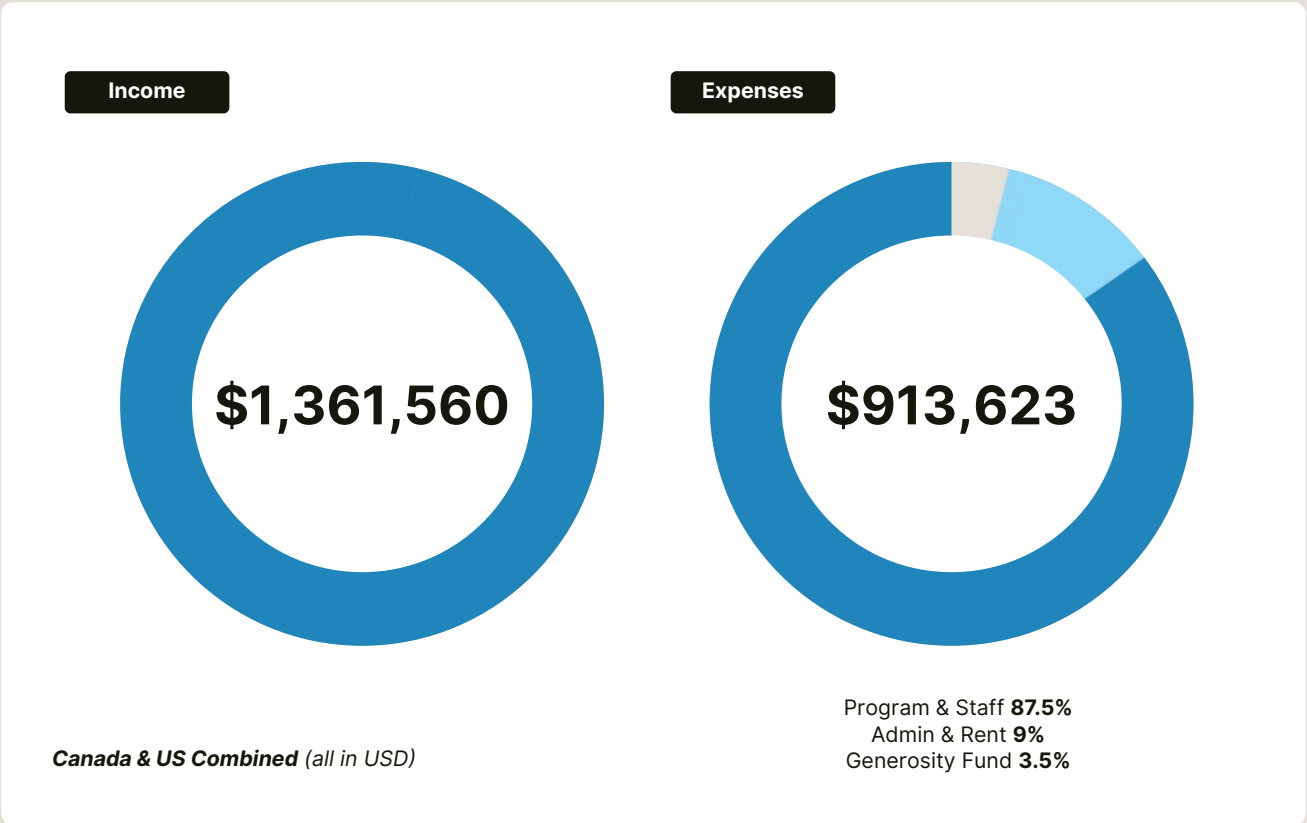


iChurch
